

Name `uptime`— returns the length of time that the DAS has been running

Synopsis `uptime`
[`--help`]

Description The `uptime` subcommand returns the length of time that the domain administration server (DAS) has been running since it was last restarted. This subcommand is supported in remote mode only, so the DAS must be running.

Options `--help`
Displays the help text for the subcommand.

Operands None.

Examples **EXAMPLE 1** Showing How Long the DAS Has Been Running

This example shows the length of time that the DAS has been running.

```
asadmin> uptime
Uptime: 23 minutes, 41 seconds
Command uptime executed successfully.
```

Exit Status 0 subcommand executed successfully
1 error in executing the subcommand
