

Name enable—enables the component

Synopsis enable
[**--help**]
[**--target** *target_name*]
[*component_name*]

Description The enable subcommand enables the specified deployed component. If the component is already enabled, then it is re-enabled. If it has not been deployed, then an error message is returned. This subcommand is supported in remote mode only.

Options **--help**
Displays the help text for the subcommand.

--target
Do not specify this option. This option is retained for compatibility with other releases. If you specify this option, a syntax error does not occur. Instead, the subcommand runs successfully and the option is silently ignored.

Operands *component_name* name of the component to be enabled.

Examples **EXAMPLE 1** Enabling a Component

This example enables the disabled component, sampleApp.

```
asadmin> enable sampleApp
Command enable executed successfully
```

Exit Status 0 subcommand executed successfully
1 error in executing the subcommand
