

Name list-components– lists deployed components

Synopsis list-components [--help] [--type *type*] [*target*]

Description The list-components subcommand lists all deployed Java EE components. If the --type option is not specified, all components are listed. The possible types are listed in the Options section in this help page.

This subcommand is supported in remote mode only.

Options --help

Displays the help text for the subcommand.

--type

Specifies the type of the components that are to be listed. The options are as follows:

- application (default)
- appclient
- connector
- ejb
- jruby
- web
- webservice

If no type is specified, all components are listed.

Operands *target*

Do not specify this option. This option is retained for compatibility with other releases. If you specify this option, a syntax error does not occur. Instead, the subcommand runs successfully and the option is silently ignored.

Examples **EXAMPLE 1** Listing Components

This example lists the connector components. (cciblackbox-tx.rar was deployed.)

```
asadmin> list-components --type connector
cciblackbox-tx connector
Command list-components executed successfully
```

Exit Status 0 subcommand executed successfully

1 error in executing the subcommand
