

Name	delete-system-property– removes one system property of the domain, configuration, cluster, or server instance, at a time				
Synopsis	<code>delete-system-property</code> [<code>--help</code>] [<code>--target</code> <i>target_name</i>] [<i>property_name</i>]				
Description	<p>The <code>delete-system-property</code> subcommand deletes system properties of a domain, configuration, cluster, or server instance.</p> <p>This subcommand is supported in remote mode only.</p>				
Options	<p><code>--help</code> Displays the help text for the subcommand.</p> <p><code>--target</code> Do not specify this option. This option is retained for compatibility with other releases. If you specify this option, a syntax error does not occur. Instead, the subcommand runs successfully and the option is silently ignored.</p>				
Operands	<p><i>property_name</i> The name of the system property to remove.</p>				
Examples	<p>EXAMPLE 1 Deleting a System Property</p> <p>This example deletes the system property named <code>http-listener-port</code>.</p> <pre>asadmin> delete-system-property http-listener-port</pre> <p>Command <code>delete-system-property</code> executed successfully.</p>
