

**Name** list-threadpools— lists all the thread pools

**Synopsis** list-threadpools [--help] [*target*]

**Description** Lists all the thread pools. This subcommand is supported in remote mode only.

**Options** --help

Displays the help text for the subcommand.

**Operands** *target*

Do not specify this option. This option is retained for compatibility with other releases. If you specify this option, a syntax error does not occur. Instead, the subcommand runs successfully and the option is silently ignored.

**Examples** EXAMPLE 1 Listing Thread Pools

This example lists the current thread pools.

```
asadmin> list-threadpools
threadpool-1
threadpool-2
Command list-threadpools executed successfully
```

**Exit Status** 0 subcommand executed successfully

1 error in executing the subcommand
