

Name list-jndi-resources– lists all existing JNDI resources

Synopsis list-jndi-resources [--help] [--target *target*]

Description Use the list-jndi-resources subcommand to identify all the existing JNDI resources.

This subcommand is supported in remote mode only.

Options --help

-?

Displays the help text for the subcommand.

--target

Do not specify this option. This option is retained for compatibility with other releases. If you specify this option, a syntax error does not occur. Instead, the subcommand runs successfully and the option is silently ignored.

Examples **EXAMPLE 1** Listing JNDI Resources

This example lists the JNDI in the default domain.

```
asadmin> list-jndi-resources
jndi_resource1
jndi_resource2
jndi_resource3
Command list-jndi-resources executed successfully
```

Exit Status 0 subcommand executed successfully

1 error in executing the subcommand
